<u>Summary of Audit Findings</u>	
<p>An on-site corporate audit with respect to Fullerton's relevant business activities' exposure to environmental and social risks was undertaken in line with CGIF's safeguard standards. Based on our findings, Fullerton's overall environmental and social risk exposure is considered "Medium" (GCF-2), based on its low to medium risk business activity (human healthcare activities) located in a country with Acceptable Risk (Singapore, Australia, Indonesia).</p> <p>Human health care activities could potentially represent some degree of environmental impact such as medical waste treatment, exposure to radiation, infection, etc. However, given that most of Fullerton's operation facilities are located in the countries which have well established regulatory regime for environment and social matters and the Fullerton's well developed environmental and social management plan, potential environmental and social impacts are expected to be manageable. Fullerton has successfully operated across the region since its establishment in 2010 without any identified environmental and social issues.</p> <p>No indigenous people or resettlement issues were identified.</p> <p>On this backdrop, no corrective action plan was deemed to be required.</p>	

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
